


FIRE & ICE

Volcanic Foundation. The largest lava flows ever documented formed a basalt foundation ideal for viticulture.

Epic Floods. Thousands of years ago cataclysmic floods inundated eastern and central Washington - bringing with them soils uniquely suited for growing grapes.

The Columbia River. The fourth largest river in North America is the main source of irrigation for the majority of Washington's vineyards.
